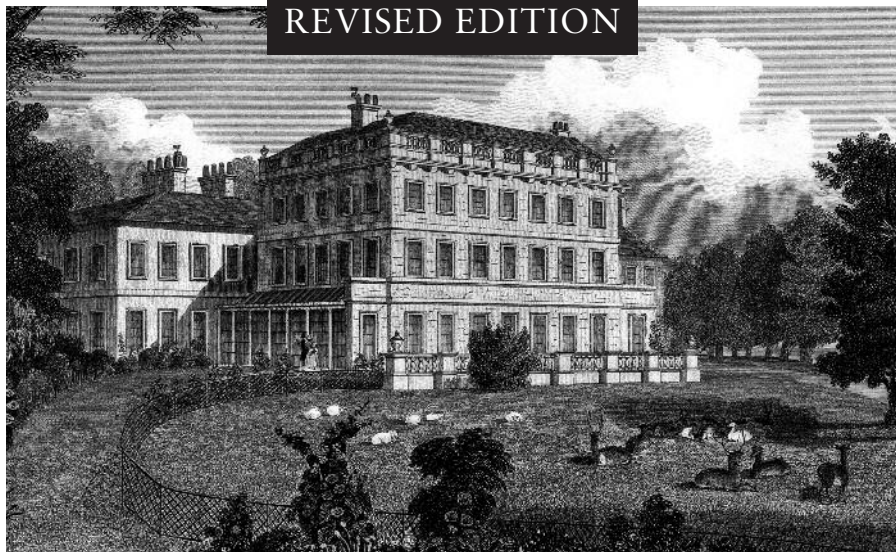


# ESCRICK

This is the first published history of the village of Escrick. Drawing on a wide range of sources, many of them unpublished, and on personal reminiscences from older inhabitants, the author has told the story of one Yorkshire village and its population from before the Norman Conquest to the present day. He describes the impact of national events like the Reformation, the Civil War, the Enclosures, the Agricultural Depression, and the two world wars on a small community and examines the interaction over the centuries between the 'big house' and the village. In this insightful and entertaining account of a small part of Britain, the reader will find a reflection of the story of the nation as a whole.

J. P. G. Taylor, M.A., has taught history in a variety of schools, most recently at Queen Margaret's, Escrick, the history of which he published in 2001.
